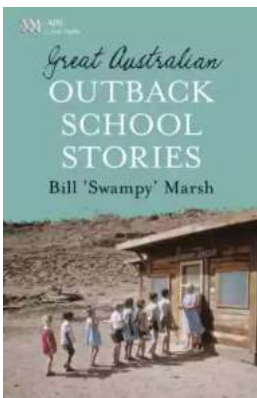


10 Unbelievable Australian Outback School Stories That Will Leave You Speechless!
