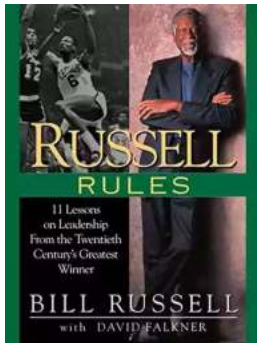

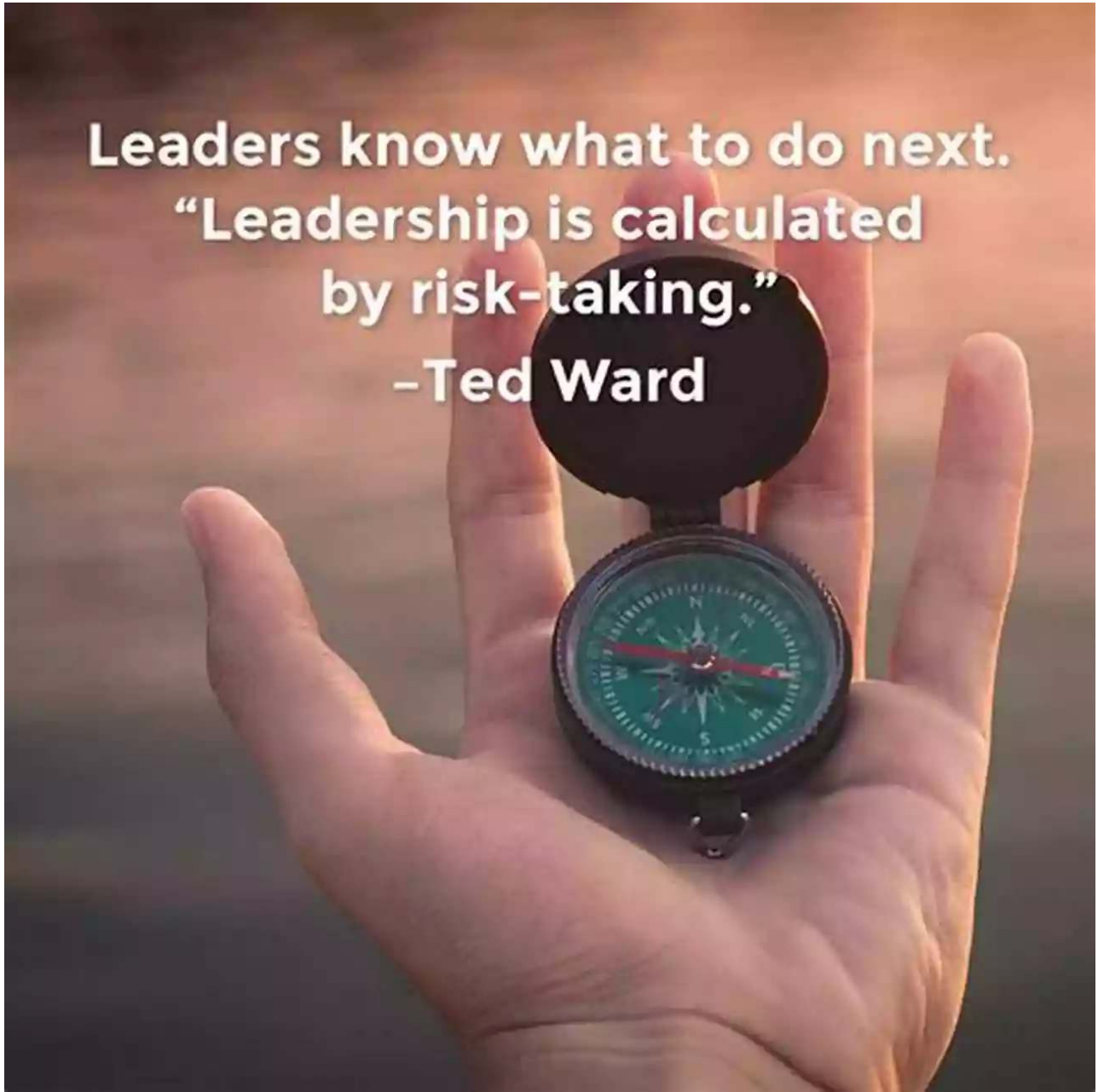

Lesson 7: Take Calculated Risks



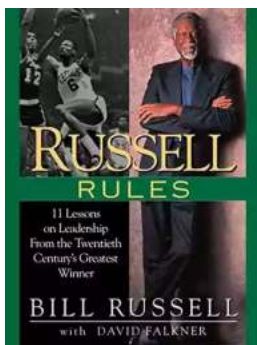
Lesson 11: Adapt to Changing Circumstances
