exceedingly cool rhythm guitar part to be learned and mastered for possible future employment when a big, fat accompaniment part is needed in a keyboard-less combo, for instance.

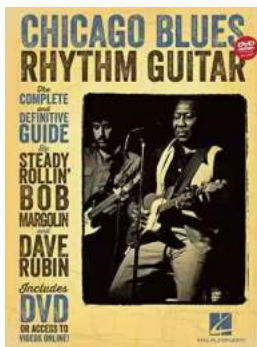

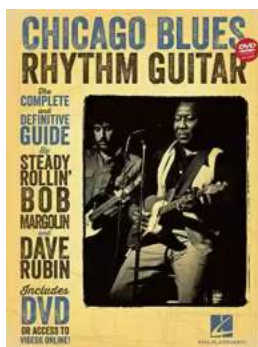

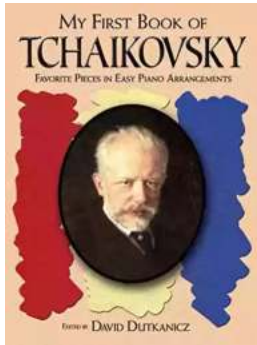
