3. Lake Koshkonong (42.821165, -88.923692)

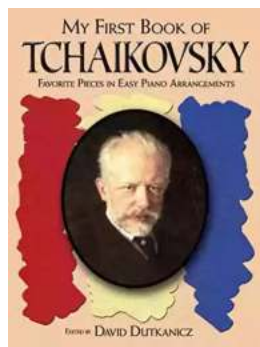
