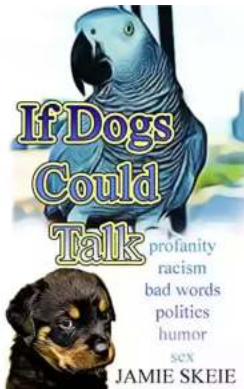

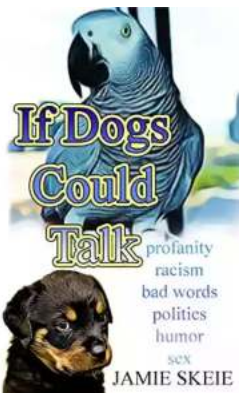

Orion learns new sentences every day. This book was created to help other pet owners...know what their pets might be thinking! Animals are smarter than some

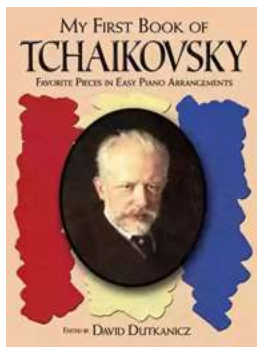
people realize. After reading, *If Dogs Could Talk*, you'll feel closer to your loved ones. You'll know what your pets would say..if they could talk!
