
## My Recent Visit To Sri Lanka: A Journey through Paradise

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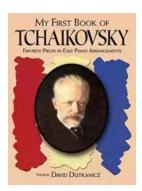
