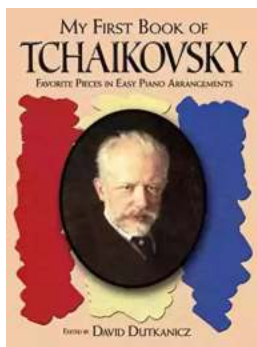
North and South is a novel by an English writer Elizabeth Gaskell.
