

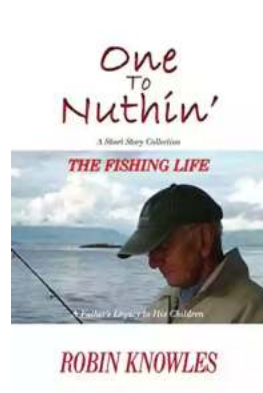

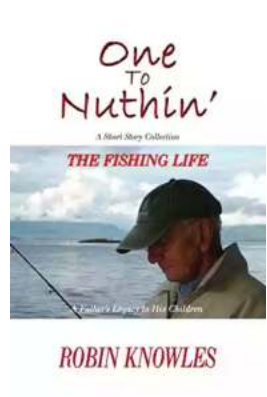

We fished and snorkeled in the Bahamas.

We fished at Fort Pierce inlet.

We fished at Ponce de Leon inlet and offshore into the Atlantic.

We still fish at Poppa's house at Lake Beresford and the St. John's River where Twig has proven her cast net prowess, and many of Poppa's grandchildren still come to fish off the seawall.

And here are the stories...

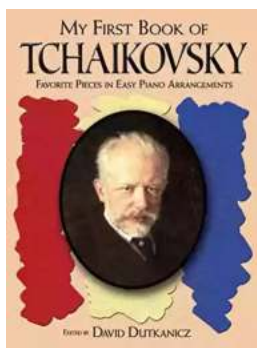
