



Most quilts have a "story"- the source of inspiration, the overall look (design, colour and patterns), the techniques required in construction, the enjoyments, frustrations and experienced along the way, how the quilt is now used or to whom it was given. In this way each quilt may develop a personality of its own. Jungian therapists believe that the personality of the quilt may become a "window on your soul". Exploring the story of the quilt can help you to better understand your own needs and your responses to life circumstances.


