



#### 5. Sprint Retrospective

Following the sprint review, the team holds a retrospective meeting to reflect on the previous sprint. They identify what went well, what could be improved, and potential action items for future sprints. This continuous improvement process empowers the team to enhance their performance and efficiency over time.
