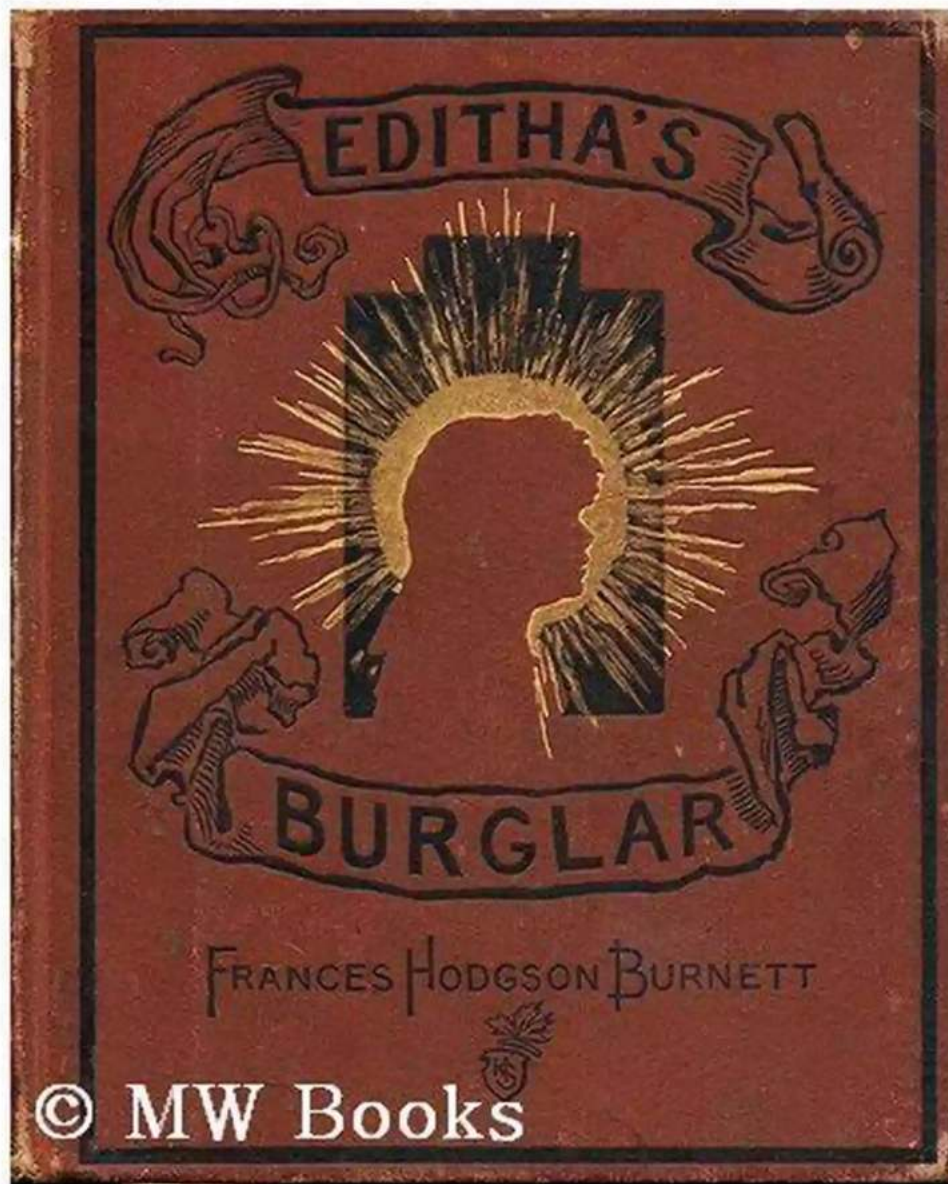

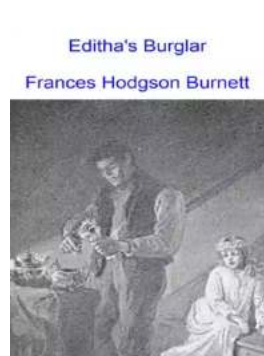

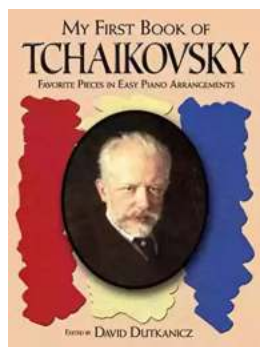
Fauntleroy, The Secret Garden, A Little Princess and many others).

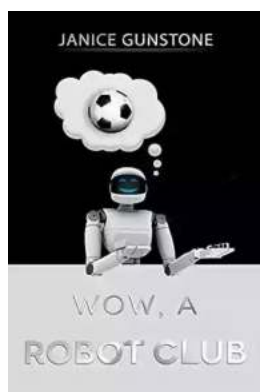
